ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

The Veer Surendra Sai University of Technology (VSSUT) Odisha was formed by Orissa Act 9 of 2009 by converting University College of Engineering (UCE), Burla to a non-affiliating Unitary University and came into force from 1st day of July 2009. This University is named after legendary Veer Surendra Sai, the great Indian freedom fighter who was born on 23rd January 1809 and sacrificed his life fighting against the British and died in obscurity in Asirgarh Jail on 28th February 1884. Situated at the foothill of world famous Hirakud dam, the early history of the University is a fascinating chapter in the story of technical education in Odisha. Established on 12th Aug. 1956, at Burla in the name of University College of Engineering (UCE), the first engineering college was functioning as a constituent college of Utkal University, Bhubaneswar. The University occupies nearly 300 acres of prime land in Burla, located at 21°30' N 83°52' E 21.5°N 83.87°E. It has an average elevation of 173 metres (567 feet). The town lies at one end of Hirakud Dam which is located around 2 km north-west of the town. The Jawahar Minar offers picturesque views of the dam, the lake and the surrounding forests of Barapahad (12 hills). At the otherside of the dam is the township of Hirakud.

ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT

The Department of Chemistry started with the establishment of University College of Engineering, BURLA, Presently, Veer Surendra Sai University of Technology, in 1956. It is one of the oldest Chemistry Departments in the State started under the founder headship of Late Prof. Sripati Pani, PhD (London). The Department infuses the basic fundamentals of Chemistry to the students at B Tech level. From the session 2010-11, the Department started MSc courses in the specialization of Industrial Chemistry and from the current session (2013-2014), 5-Year Integrated MSc Programme as well as 1-Year M.Phil programme have been started. The syllabus of the postgraduate courses includes emerging areas of Chemical Science such as Nanochemistry, Green Chemistry, Supramolecular Chemistry along with conventional topics as per UGC norms and latest courses of the NET, GATE etc. Further, research scholars are enrolled in the Department of Chemistry leading to Doctoral Degree. Besides, the department is engaged in testing of chemical and engineering materials supplied by many national, state-level and local industries such as Indian Railways, HINDALCO, MCL, Vedanta group of industries, Water Resource department, Hirakud Dam project, Department of National Highways, etc

Venue and Location

The conference will be held in the Department of Chemistry, VSSUT, Burla. The Burla town is piquant and truly a university town as it hosts the Sambalpur University, the VSS Medical College and the Veer Surendra Sai University of Technology, Burla, besides numerous schools and colleges.
